

**Description**

Primate dietary multiple vitamins formulated to provide for the normal daily vitamin needs of most non-human primates. Convenient sized tablets, highly palatable and made with stable forms of fat-soluble and water-soluble vitamins. Each tablet has a uniform size and precision weight of 3 grams.

**Ingredients**

Dried corn syrup, maltodextrin, microcrystalline cellulose, fructose, L-ascorbyl-2-polyphosphate (source of vitamin C), d-alpha tocopheryl acetate (source of natural vitamin E), nicotinic acid, magnesium stearate, calcium pantothenate, artificial flavors, orange oil, vitamin A acetate, pyridoxine hydrochloride, riboflavin, thiamin mononitrate, cholecalciferol (source of vitamin D<sub>3</sub>), folic acid, menadione sodium bisulfite (source of vitamin K), biotin.

**Feeding Directions**

Provide as a dietary source of vitamins to rapidly growing and adult animals deemed in need of such supplemental vitamins. For best results, feed daily with or immediately after meals. For instance, use one tablet daily for 20 to 70 kg animals; an additional tablet for each 70 kg of animal weight. Young animals up to 20 kg need 1/2 of this tablet daily or one tablet every other day.
